A Traditional Balinese woven Fabric is called an Endek

As a product of artifacts and cultural identity, Endek is commonly used by Balinese people while performing various custom rituals in Pura. At the beginning of the 18th century, it becomes a status symbol, like the Balinese songket, the Endek cloth was worn by the nobles and certain people at that time.



These Endeks are hand woven and dyed with natural dyes (wash only in cold water and separately)
